D1 SINGAPORE → INCHEON

Assemble at Changi Airport to check in for your flight to Incheon International Airport, Korea.

D2 INCHEON → PAJU GIMPO → JEJU ISLAND

- **Korean Demilitarized Zone (DMZ):** A border zone that separates North Korea and South Korea, including the **3rd Infiltration Tunnel, Imjingak Park, Dora Observatory and Dorasan Station.**
- Take a domestic flight to **Jeju Island.**
- **Dragon Head Rock:** A natural lava formation resembling a dragon head, created by storming winds and waves over thousands of years ago.
- **Cave Café:** Enjoy a detoxifying green tea foot bath at **Daheeyon Garden.**

(Lunch/Dinner)

D3 JEJU ISLAND

- **Seongsan Sunrise Peak:** Jeju's top attraction – An extinct volcanic crater jutting out to the sea.
- **Seongeup Folk Village:** A well-preserved traditional Jeju village which houses multiple cultural highlights.

- **Jusangjeolli Cliffs:** An impressive rock pillar formed by basaltic lava.
- **O'Sulloc Tea Museum:** Teaches visitors about Korea's traditional tea culture.
- **Tangerine Farm:** Experience fruit picking (subject to seasonal conditions) & enjoy photo taking in Canola Flower Farm.

D4 JEJU ISLAND → BUSAN DAEGU

- Take a domestic flight to **Busan.**
- **Nampodong Fashion Street:** The street captures the heart of fashion, art and culture in Busan.
- **Jagalchi Market:** Busan's most famous traditional seafood market.
- **Gamcheon Cultural Village:** Catch a sight of Busan's famed mosaic houses built on slopes.
- **Sky Walk:** A floating sky walk that offers the best views of **Oryukdo Island.**
- Transfer to Daegu to stay the night.

D5 DAEGU → YONGPYONG

- **Skylake:** Experience making your own shampoo with natural & oriental ingredients. (Grape picking will be replaced by skylake around late August to late October)
- **DIY traditional wine bread.**
- **The Second Seokguram:** It was built in the 7th century during the Silla Dynasty.
- **DIY Fried Chicken & Tomato Pasta** for either lunch or dinner
- Transfer to **YongPyong Resort** to stay the night.

D6 YONGPYONG → KOREA FOLK VILLAGE → SEOUL

- **YongPyong Water Peak Island:** Enjoy some spa, sauna or water activities. (Please bring your swimwear and swimming cap. In the event of Yongpyong Water Park's annual maintenance, an alternative attraction will be replaced.)
- **Pyeongchang Uiyaji Wind Village:**

Enjoy the beautiful sight of windmills standing high above the plain.

- **Korea Folk Village:** Center of Korean Wave and home of many historical dramas.
- **Hongdae:** Home to unique cafes, cosy galleries, accessory stores, boutiques and gourmet eateries made this a popular hangout for local youth and a fascinating place to explore.

D7 SEOUL

- **Gyeongbok Palace (includes Korean Traditional Hanbok Costume):** The main and largest palace of the five grand palaces built during the Joseon Dynasty. Explore the Palace in a **Hanbok.**
- **Shopping Spree:** Ginseng, Bo Kan Yeong and Cosmetic Duty-Free Outlet.
- **Myeongdong:** Shop to your heart's delight at one of the most fashionable shopping streets in Seoul.
- **CHEF (new brand Bibap):** A non-verbal performance depicting one of Korea's representative dishes - Bibimbap.

D8 SEOUL → INCHEON → SINGAPORE

- **Shopping spree:** Seaweed Showroom, Amethyst Outlet and Local Products Shop.
- Transfer to Incheon International Airport for our flight back to Singapore. We hope that you have had an enjoyable time with SA Tours!
