Discover daily life on the 130 year old Warrook Farm in Gippsland.

A working farm of 165 acres with a gracious century-old homestead and fauna park, visitors from all over the world are welcomed to experience traditional farm life, try their hand at old-style farm activities and immerse themselves in the romance and history of Australia's great sheep and cattle stations.

- sheep shearing
- milk the cow
- kangaroos feeding
- dogs round up sheep

Australian native trees to encourage wildlife back to the area, the Warrook Farm fauna park is alive with the chatter of colourful birds, kangaroos along with emus, wombats, deer, goats, a miniature donkey and alpacas. Geese and ducks float on the dam which attracts even more birdlife. Warrook Farm is half way between Melbourne and Phillip Island, and is the perfect spot to stop for lunch in the licensed restaurant or casual café. Western, and halal menus are served. Devonshire teas are a popular afternoon feature, with house-made scones, and lashings of jam and cream.
